

## ORDINANCE 2026-2

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE UPDATED VERSION OF THE VILLAGE OF VANLUE ZONING REGULATIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The Village Council having been made aware of the fact that the existing zoning regulations have not been updated in several years and that a number of its provisions needed to reviewed, revised, and approved by the Village Council, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Ordinance be issued in adopt the updated version of the zoning regulations;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Vanlue, State of Ohio, Two-Thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: That the updated version of the Village of Vanlue Zoning Regulations is approved and adopted as the Zoning Regulations for the Village of Vanlue.

SECTION 2: That a complete copy of the updated version of the Village of Vanlue Zoning Regulations shall be maintained at the village offices.


SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after April 20, 2026.
